Animal Control

The City of Eastland adopted various animal related ordinances over the years. Some of those include a Running at Large or "Leash Law" which requires all dogs to be behind a fence or on a leash at all times; Animal Nuisance which is to control barking dogs; Prohibited Animals; Livestock; Vaccination of animals and Restricting the number of cats/dogs to 4 at any one residence.

The City of Eastland owns and operates an Animal Control Facility, or "Pound", where running at large, unclaimed or quarantined animals are kept. A Foster Program is available and many animals are adopted through the facility. Unfortunately not all animals are so lucky and the city does have to euthanize many animals each year.

You can help the Eastland Animal Control Department by seeing to it your pets are vaccinated, spayed or neutered and remain on your property either behind a fence, pet enclosure or on a leash.

Fire Protection for the City of Eastland is provided through a department made up of 3 paid firemen and a volunteer program of approximately 25 members.

Supported through a combination of City tax dollars and volunteer fundraisers and citizen donations, the department purchases and builds much of the equipment housed at the Eastland Fire Station.

Utilities 629-8321

The City of Eastland offers residential and commercial customers city water and sewer services. (Garbage services are offered through a contract with Progressive Waste Services) For more information on how to establish city utilities services, please stop by City Hall or give us a call.

Water 629-8321

Treated water is provided by the City of Eastland through contract with the Eastland County Water Supply District.

All habitable, residential addresses are required by city ordinance to be connected to the city water system.

Sewer 629-8321

Wastewater is treated at the City Wastewater Treatment Plant located in the south east portion of the city.

All habitable, residential addresses are required by city ordinance to be connected to the city sewage system. Septic systems are not allowed within the city limits.

Solid Waste Services 629-8321

Weekly, bi weekly or daily garbage collection is provided through a contract with Progressive Waste Services (formerly known as IESI) and is billed along with city provided water and sewer accounts for residential and commercial addresses located within the city limits.

Through the PWI contract, twice monthly bulk pickup services are offered to customers free of charge. For more information on the Bulk Pickup Services drop by City Hall and pickup a brochure or go to www.cityofeastland.com and click on the Solid Waste Management link.

A City Convenience Center is also available to those residents who have the means to haul away their own bulk and brush items.

Streets 629-8321

The City constructs and maintains City owned streets throughout the majority of the City excluding East and West Main, and North and South Seaman. These are maintained by the State of Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT).

An ongoing street repair, replacement, upgrade program is scheduled for each year during the spring and summer months based on the current temperatures.

Parks 629-8321

The City of Eastland Parks Department maintains the main City Park, the Eastland City Cemetery, the Six Flags Park, Friendship Park, as well as the City owned baseball complex and other areas of the city. This department works hard year round, but especially during the spring and summer months to keep these areas looking nice for our residents and visitors.

Planning, Zoning, Code Compliance 629-8321

To ensure the cohesiveness, safety and well being of our citizens and community, the City Commission elected some years ago to accomplish this through proper planning, zoning and the enactment of ordinances.

The Planning department monitors developments in the city, and any new construction, reconstruction, added construction of structures within the city limits. Building permits are required in many instances.

The Zoning Department works hand in hand with Planning in the development of the city by designating commercial, residential, agricultural and industrial development locations.

Code Compliance ensures the Code of Ordinances adopted over the years are being complied with by the community.

Municipal Court 629-8227

The City of Eastland Municipal court handles cases filed through traffic and other criminal citations issued by the Eastland Police Department and Code Compliance Department. The court is manned by a full time Deputy Court Clerk and by a visiting judge.

City Secretary 629-8321

The City Secretary is responsible for recording the minutes of all City of Eastland City Commission meetings, as well as minutes of the various advisory boards within the city.

The City Secretary also is responsible for setting, and conducting all City related elections.

This office also handles all requests for public information.

City Registrar 629-8321

This office is responsible for recording all births and deaths that happen within the city limits and making certified copies of these records available to the public.

City Cemetery 629-8321

The historic City Cemetery is owned and operated by the City of Eastland. Professional grave services are provided privately through the funeral home of your choice. A Cemetery Directory is available at the marble kiosk located next to the War Memorials and online at www.eastlandtexas.com/cemetery.

A self guided walking tour of the cemetery will introduce you to many historical figures in the history of Eastland, Eastland County and Texas.
