EEDI Director Tom Bailey introduced this item. He also introduced Andy Hansen from Trafalgar Homes. Mr. Bailey talked about the project at hand. He showed a slide presentation of where the land is located that is the proposed site of Maverick Town Homes in Eastland. It showed utility lines and the street right of way. Trafalgar Homes has built many complexes in the surrounding areas including, Stephenville, Early, and Brownwood. There were photos of those complexes.

Mr. Bailey explained the issue that is happening because of the way the street is designed and the right of way that extends past the street. We are asking the City to help with constructing the entrance on the 40 feet of property up to where the Trafalgar Homes property begins. Mr. Hansen

stated that they usually only have to construct 8-10 feet of the entrance but since this is 40 feet, it will cost approximately \$9500 in additional funds. He stated that the entrance will be constructed of heavy-duty concrete and rebar. Also, within 35 feet of the property line, they will be giving the City utility easements.

Mr. Hansen stated that they plan to construct 28 units, which includes both Town Homes and apartments.
