**Hours of Operation:**

Closed on Wednesdays

**HOURS: 1:00 to 5:30 every day except Wednesday.**

Evening Swim: 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday only

**TUESDAY** evening will be Adult and Family Swim, no unaccompanied children under age 17 allowed.

**We begin accepting reservations at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 16 at City Hall.**

**THIS DATE IS FOR IN PERSON RESERVATIONS ONLY. No phone reservations made on May 16. Phone reservations will be accepted beginning Wednesday, May 17.**

**Party dates begin Friday, June 2; final party date Sunday, July 30**

**Hours:**

2 hour period 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday

Set-up for party may begin at 6:00 p.m., no earlier.

**Fees:**

Total number of patrons in facility including non-swimmers

0 – 49            150.00 deposit 100.00

50 – 99           250.00 deposit 125.00

100 – 149        300.00 deposit 150.00

Parties will be scheduled in advance with City Hall and require a deposit which will be applied to the total fee. The balance must be paid in full two weeks in advance of the party date. Patrons will be required to read the party rules and cancellation policy, and then sign a form indicating they were read before a reservation will be finalized.
