The maximum height for a sign in this location is 60 feet when located fifteen feet from curb line, with an additional foot of height allowed for every additional 10 feet from curbside. Variance is required in order to build a new 75-foot tall commercial pole sign to replace an existing sign located at 11619 Interstate 20, being Sec. 1, B3, H&TC Survey, Abstract 260, Eastland, Texas.
